Station Requirements and Parkour Behaviours Rules and Regulations

Parkour Behaviours

The Parkour Behaviours required for the Puppy Level 0 are:-

- 2 feet on
- 4 feet on
- Under
- In

Puppy Level 0

The parkour behaviours, station requirements and obstacle requirements are shown in Table A

Videoing

Both you and the dog need to be clearly visible in each video.

Must be able to see dog getting onto and off each of the obstacles

Each behaviour can be videoed separately and can be videoed in a different location on a different day

All 10 videos need to be edited together so that one video with all 10 behaviours is submitted

Video Submission

Upload both videos to You Tube.

- 6. Dogs Age (minimum age is 2 months)
- 7. Name of your Certified Instructor (if you have one)

Submission Fee

The submission fee (£25 – GBP British Pounds) is for one handler with one dog. Non-qualifying submissions can resubmit for a resubmission fee of £10

Rules

Each video must show the dog successfully demonstrating the behaviour Treats or toys may be carried in pocket or treat pouch Treats or toys may not be used to lure dog to perform the behaviour Treats/toys can be given after the behaviour has been completed If necessary, you are required to hold an obstacle to make it safe for your dog Dogs must be wearing a non-tightening non-shoulder restrictive harness with a lead attached to a back clip on the harness for all stations except for a 'under' station when the lead may be unclipped for the 'under' behaviour Handler must not touch the dog while the dog is performing the behaviour No harsh handling

No manipulating/pushing/shoving/lifting dog or any part of the dog's body to get them to do the behaviour.

Minimum age of dog is 2 months

The lead must not be held so tightly that it pulls a dog onto an obstacle or prevents a dog from dismounting from an obstacle.

Rosettes and Certificates

A Dog Parkour UK Level 0 Puppy Qualifying Certificate and Qualifying Rosette will be awarded to Teams who successfully complete the requirements.

Obstacles

A different obstacle must be used for each of the ten stations

Built Environment

Any man-made obstacles can be used – obstacles must meet specified requirements

Obstacle needs to be moveable i.e. of a size that you can move it into the position that you want to use it in.

Obstacles can be placed in any location (indoors or outdoors)

Four different textures should be used for stations 1, 2, 5 and 6 e.g. carpet, rubber, hessian, plastic

Table A – Built Environment – Puppy Level 0

Station Number	Level 0	Behaviour
	Parkour Behaviour	Requirements
1	2 feet on (Texture 1) Obstacle must be low	Dog puts two front feet onto the obstacle and stays in that position for at least 1 second. Obstacle must be a different texture to stations 2, 5 and 6
2	4 feet on (Texture 2) Obstacle must be low	Dog puts four feet onto the obstacle and stays in that position for at least 1 second. Obstacle must be a different texture to stations 1, 5 and 6
3	Under	Dog goes under an obstacle slightly higher than head height (lead may be detached for this). Dog should not have to duck their head to pass under the obstacle
4	In	Dog gets into an obstacle with four sides and stays in the obstacle for 1 second. Sides of obstacle to be no higher than stopper pad height
5	2 feet on (Texture 3) Obstacle must be low	Dog puts two front feet onto the obstacle and stays in that position for at least 1 second. Obstacle must be a different texture to stations 1, 2 and 6
6	4 feet on (Texture 4) Obstacle must be low	Dog puts four feet onto the obstacle and stays in that position for at least 1 second. Obstacle must be a different texture to stations 1, 2 and 5
7	Free Choice 1 Obstacle must meet requirement for behaviour	Any Level 0 parkour behaviour Must be different to the free choice behaviour demonstrated for station 8
8	Free Choice 2 Obstacle must meet requirement for behaviour	Any Level 0 parkour behaviour Must be different to the free choice behaviour demonstrated for station 7
9	Creativity Obstacle must meet requirement for behaviour	Dog to do two different Level 0 parkour behaviours with one obstacle.
10	2 Obstacle Sequence Obstacles must meet requirement for behaviour	Dog to do two different Level 0 parkour behaviours one after the other using two different obstacles.
